


-Manipulate your manipulative to urge communication -Store manipulative in containers that will require students to ask for help to "open"

-Choose books and passages that lend themselves to use of Core Vocabulary (lines that repeat, predictable sequencing)


-Repeat, repeat, repeat to give students practice to utilize key vocabulary to insure success
