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Why Technology?

All students learn in different ways. Some students respond best using technologies to be successful. Technology is a way that students can interact with information. Many students are extremely motivated by technology. There are many free resources on the internet. Let's check them out...

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SoundingBoard

- This app comes with 14 preloaded boards. (these can be edited to customize).
- The voice is nice and clear on the pre-recorded boards and has a clear voice for the self-recorded cells.

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SoundingBoard

- Create your own board (1,2,3,4,6,9 cells)- **now can go up to 20 cells!** You no longer choose a preconfigured arrangement. Can add a cell and delete a cell at any time.
- Choose from an in-app picture library of 1,298 pics, download pic, or take photos with IPAD camera.

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SoundingBoard

- Additional boards can also be purchased through AbleNet and down loaded. (inexpensive)
- Switch scanning can be used or audio scanning.
- Unlimited capacity
- Edit mode can be locked
- Boards can link to other boards.

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SoundingBoard

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SoundingBoard

- Rotation support for viewing in portrait or landscape mode
- Communication board export and import feature added-Can send and upload boards

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- Data collection- most popular boards # of activations, # of activations per picture/symbol.
- This data can then be emailed.

- What do you want to work for?
- What do you want to eat?
- What color shirt do you want to wear?
- Who do you want to sit by in class?

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SoundingBoard

Communication Systems-

- Create multiple boards to use when device is unavailable
- Create multiple boards to use when need a smaller device to carry
- Create multiple boards to use for structured times of the day
- Create pre-made social starters

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SoundingBoard

Social stories/directions

- Take multiple pictures of steps to take for a certain behavior
- Have one cell per screen, link each to the picture of the next step
- Record verbally what is expected of student during each step

Brushing your teeth, playing on the playground, walking down the hall.

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Alexicom AAC

- The ability to create speaking, linking pages that never expire in the app. (up to 48 cells per page)
- Text to Speech and recorded audio.
- Data tracking - 30 days of activity are logged. (time and date)
- Camera image acquisition directly in the cells.
- 36 editable demo pages – link to other pages as well
- Can use on computer or IPAD

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ChoiceBoard Creator

Create choice boards: number of boxes/choices, box size, downloaded images, a reward sound, and a "correct" indicator. This is nice to use for a child to make a choice of what they are working for, what activity they want to do, who they want to work with, what is wrong, etc.

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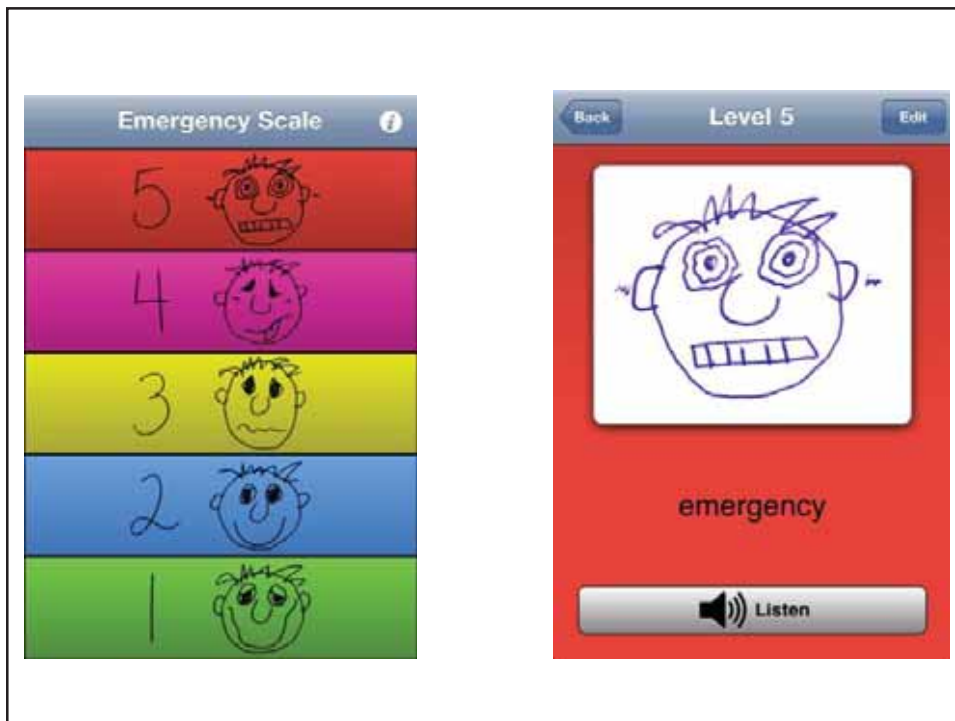

A reward sound after 5 task completed. Every time a task is completed the child taps one of the items in the row. This provides a small reinforce. After 5 there is cheering.

There are currently over 20 books that you can record being read for free. Over 500 for a fee. It also includes a small video in the corner of the person actually reading the book.

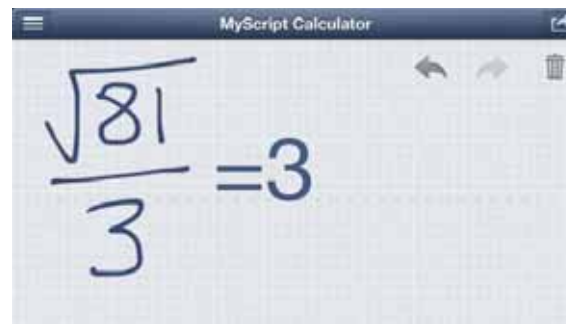


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MyScript Calculator

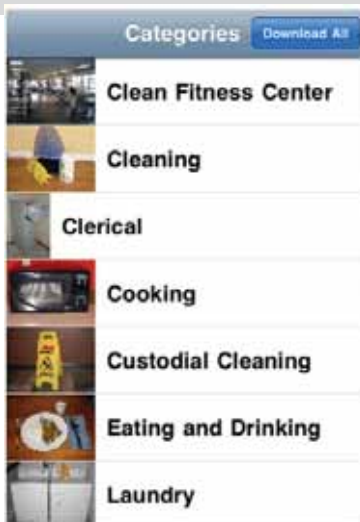

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Feel Electric!

Great video. Children talk directly to the user.

*“today I feel” – can choose from multiple different emotion words. If you do not know what they mean you can tap the word and it shows a picture and provide a description.

*My life- Mood Dude. Talks about facial expressions. You tap on a face and change the expression by changing the eyes, eye brows, and mouth.

*My Life – Mood Tales. The user chooses words from a list that then get placed into a story about a specific emotion to make a funny story.

*My Life- Moodosphere. Talk about what mood you have been reporting you were in.

*There are other games that include matching the emotion to the situation
