





Sunflower Growing Contest


- Students plant Sunflower Seeds (Mammoth Russian)
- After 2 weeks plants are thinned and one is assigned to each students
- Height is measured every 2 weeks, recorded and entered into Excel spreadsheet by students
- Bar Graph is created in Excel to compare heights
- Each student gets a certificate and prizes are awarded (1st, 2nd & 3rd tallest, shortest, first head, largest head, ?)




Bar Graph – Visually Compares Items


Sunflowers at 2 Weeks


Sunflowers at 4 Weeks: Stacked Bar Chart








Measuring Sunflowers at 11 Weeks






