# What is Social Media?

- A sharing platform for users to connect with each other regardless of location in real time





# Why is Social Media Relevant to AAC Users?

- An inclusive platform for everyone
- Allows users to interact no matter without the need to physically speak
- Integrating social media access in to AAC devices is convenient and accessible for the users
- Users can develop social skills and form friendships



# How Can Social Media be Accessed by an AAC User?

- Integration in to AAC Devices
- Scanning e.g. iOS scanning, device scanning, etc.
- Tracking solutions e.g. Head mouse, TrackerPro, Eye Gaze can all be used to access social media.

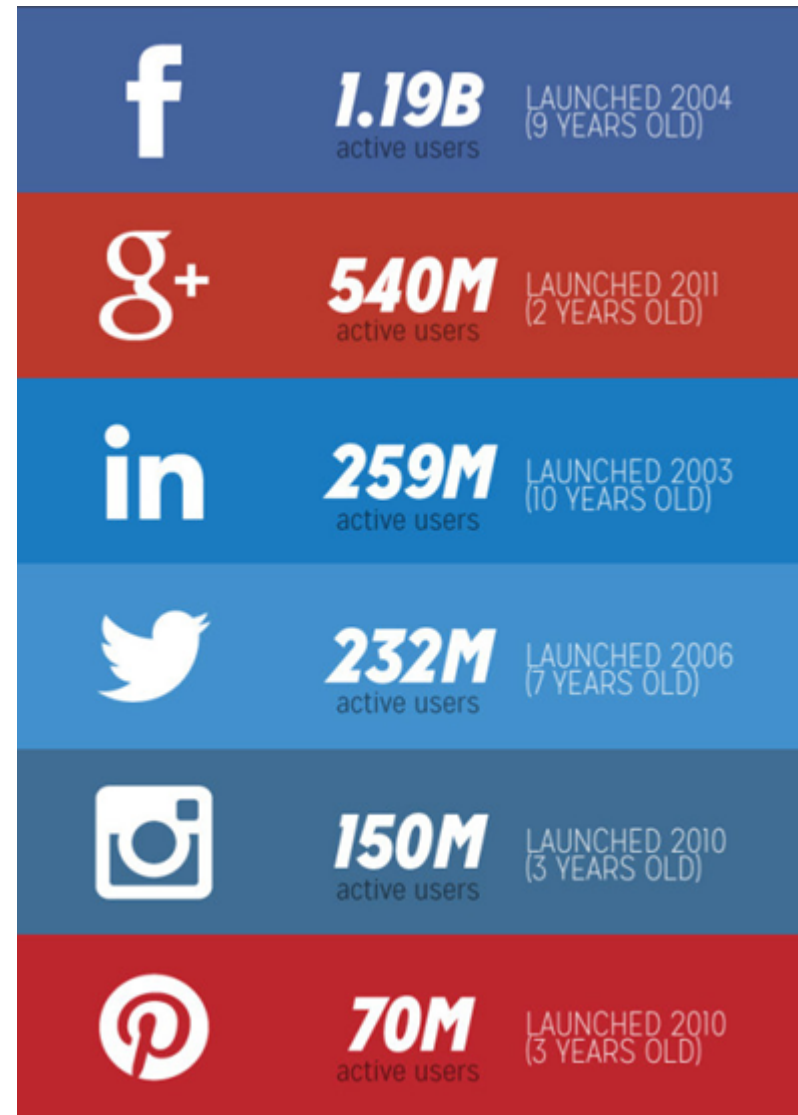
## Social media users among all adults

Twitter	19

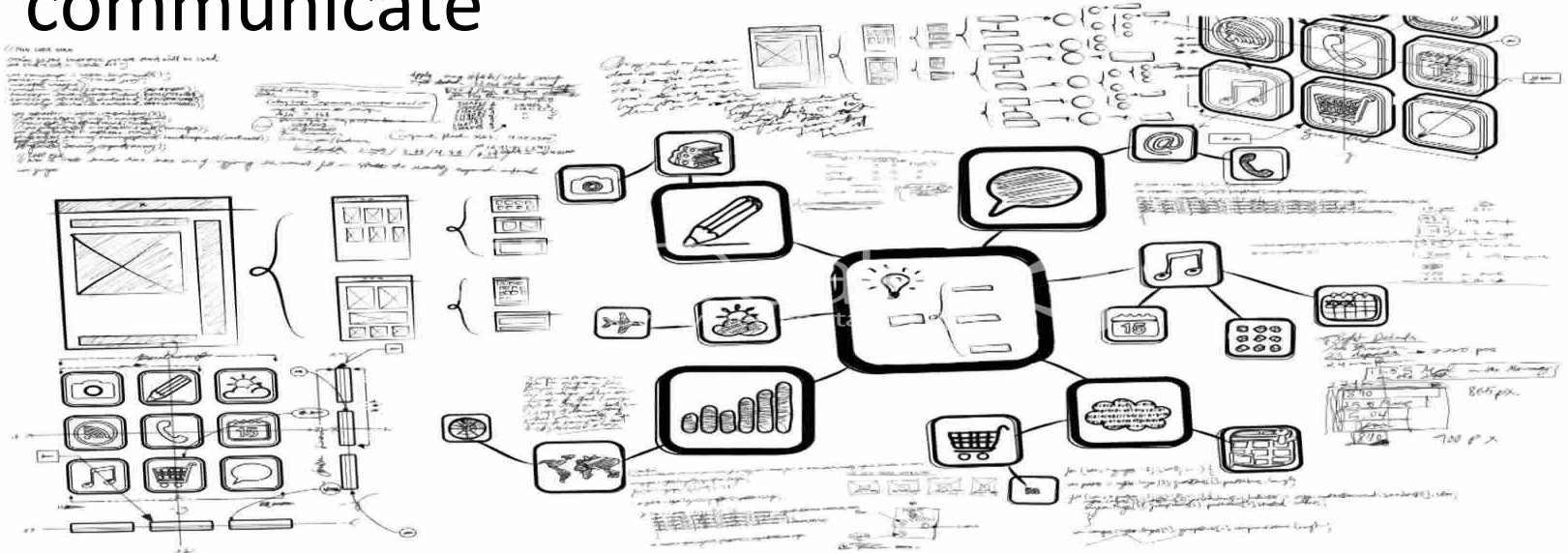

# From an App Developer's Perspective

- Social Media access is expected – it's the norm
- Practical for the user – all in one place
- Can be controlled through in app accessibility e.g. scanning
- Provides an extra way for the user to communicate



# Benefits of Social Media to an AAC User

- Exposes the user to a range of vocabulary
- Informal environment
- Integrated on AAC devices
- Posting, writing, tweeting, etc from the users device





# Protection



- Security and password protection
- Limit access to acceptable web pages
- Buddy up or use with family or a caregiver
- Block or unfollow users
- Guided Access – block out certain features

# Social Media in AAC Apps

- Facebook
- Twitter
- Skype
- iMessage
- Email



# Skype

- Skype has been integrated in to Predictable and ChatAble
- World's first AAC app with Skype capability
- Make's the user able to communicate using their device with some one on Skype



# Facebook & Twitter

- Post directly from AAC app
- Your contacts can see what the user has written
- User has access without leaving the app
- Accessible to switch users





# iMessage & Email

- Send an SMS (iMessage) from the users iDevice to another iDevice
- E.g. The user can send an iMessage from ChatAble on their iPad to their friends iPhone
- Users can email anyone directly from their app
- Internet Access required

# Conclusion

- Social Media integration allows an AAC to connect
- Social Media is the norm
- Opens up further realms of communication for AAC users
- Makes social media accessible through AAC device integration

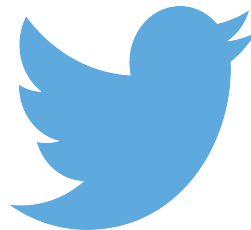
