

Communicating with AAC Devices in Everyday Situations

Objective:

Students will be able to use their AAC devices to communicate effectively in everyday situations.

Materials:

AAC devices with appropriate software and communication apps
Scenarios and role-play scripts for common everyday situations.

Introduction (5 minutes)
