AAC Valentine's Day Cards:

Activity Description: Create Valentine's Day cards using AAC devices.

Skills Practiced: This activity encourages exploration of the core words in meaningful contexts, enhances creative expression, and provides a tangible connection between AAC use and everyday communication.

How it Works: Set up different scenarios where expressing love and affection is appropriate – for example, thanking a friend, expressing love to family members, or even showing appreciation for pets. Participants use their AAC devices to formulate phrases with the core words. Encourage them to be imaginative and personalize their messages.

Skills Practiced: This helps in understanding the emotional context of words, improves social interaction skills, and reinforces the use of core words in various social situations.
