The goal is for each participant to navigate their AAC device to communicate about the items they find related to winter. Please encourage them to use complete sentences when possible.

Snowman

Snowflake

Cold

Ice

Mitten

Scarf

Firewood

Tree

Tips for Use:

- 1 Help/show the individual how to navigate to each word on the device.
- 2 Ask questions about “where” they found each item (e.g., the snow is in the sky!)
- 3 For more of a challenge, ask them to use describing words (e.g., “something that is white”, the snowman is white.)
- 4 Help create sentences using a carrier phrase, such as “I found + _____.”
