St. Patrick's Day Vocabulary Expansion

Create a set of St. Patrick's Day-themed vocabulary cards or symbols. Include words and phrases related to the holiday, such as "leprechaun," "rainbow," "pot of gold," "green," "parade," and "Ireland." Encourage users to practice these words in sentences or questions.

Find the Leprechaun

Interactive Game: Hide a symbol or picture of a leprechaun within a set of other St. Patrick's Day symbols. Participants must navigate the symbols to find the leprechaun, encouraging exploration and interaction with the AAC device.

Pot of Gold Counting Game

Use real or fake coins and a small pot or container to create a counting and sorting game. Have participants count coins into the pot, sort by size or color if possible, and use phrases or sentences to discuss the activity. This can incorporate math skills along with AAC device use.

Emphasizing the collection aspect of the game, this name invites participants to gather as many green items or symbols as possible.
